

The 505 Euro Cup 2006 Rules

1. Regattas

The 2006 505 Euro Cup consists of the following regattas:

14-16 April:	Cavalaire, France
25-28 May:	Riva del Garda, Italy
17-20 June:	Kiel Week, Germany
30 June - 2 July:	European Championship, Kaløvig, Århus, Denmark

2. Scoring system

The Euro Cup will be scored using the low point system counting the final position from each of the regattas – with one possible discard if a team participated in all four. The result of the final regatta cannot be discarded.

The points given for a regatta in which a team does not participate (start at least once) is the total number of participants in the E-Cup series.

Any boat participating in any of the regattas will automatically be registered under the name of the helmsman. Boats and crew can be changed freely during the series.

3. Sponsor prizes

All sponsor prizes of a value exceeding the entry fee will be awarded at a lottery according to the rules below. Sponsor prizes of lesser value may be awarded at the organiser's discretion.

The lottery prizes will be awarded randomly based on the number of lots accumulated by each team throughout the series. 100 lots are awarded for every finished race in the series. Furthermore the winner will receive an additional 100 lots followed by 99 lots for the runner up and so forth until number 100 hundred who will receive 1 lot.

The lottery prizes will be drawn at a joint event on the evening before the last days races (all teams are awarded 300 lots representing the last day's races).

The lottery prizes will be drawn in increasing order of value. No team can win more than one prize, possibly excepting a main prize to be drawn last of all, where all teams participate regardless of whether they have already won another prize. The minimum value of a prize to be drawn here is that of the entrance fee.

4. The authority

The 505 Euro Cup is organised by a sub committee under the International 505 association.
